- What is it?

It is an organisation that has organized work-placements (UK) / internships (US) (des stages) abroad (à l'étranger) since 1998 for volunteers (bénévoles).

- What do they offer?

They offer all sorts of internships such as Island conservation in the Seychelles or teaching to children in South Africa for example.

- What is its objective?

a) *Make students develop some skills (compétences) so that they can be more employable (apte au travail).*

Help them get experience = good for a CV.

b) *Help local communities, protect the environment.*

Support sustainability (le développement durable).
